

Field technicians needed for sharp-tailed grouse research

May – July 2025

The Wildlife Habitat Ecology Lab at Montana State University is hiring three technicians to assist with a study on the movements and demographics of sharp-tailed grouse reintroduced to two sites near Missoula, MT. This project is a collaboration with the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks.

Fieldwork will include radio-telemetry of grouse, locating and monitoring nests, tracking and monitoring broods, and collecting vegetation measurements.

Technician positions will run late April to early August. Salary is \$750 per week, with housing provided near Missoula, MT.
