The **Fair Entry Help Guide** was emailed the end of May and is also available on ZSuite. Fair entries are due **Monday, June 22 by 5 pm**. You will receive an email from Fair Entry confirming that your entries have been submitted.

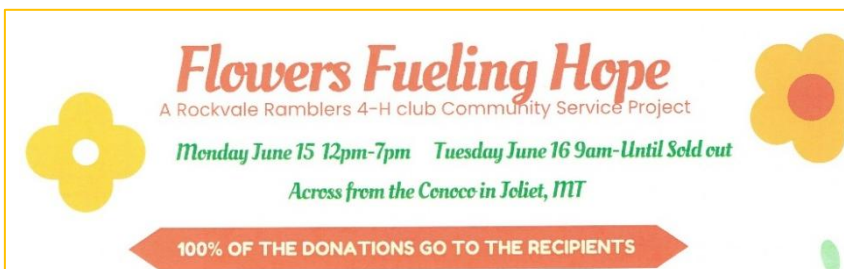
