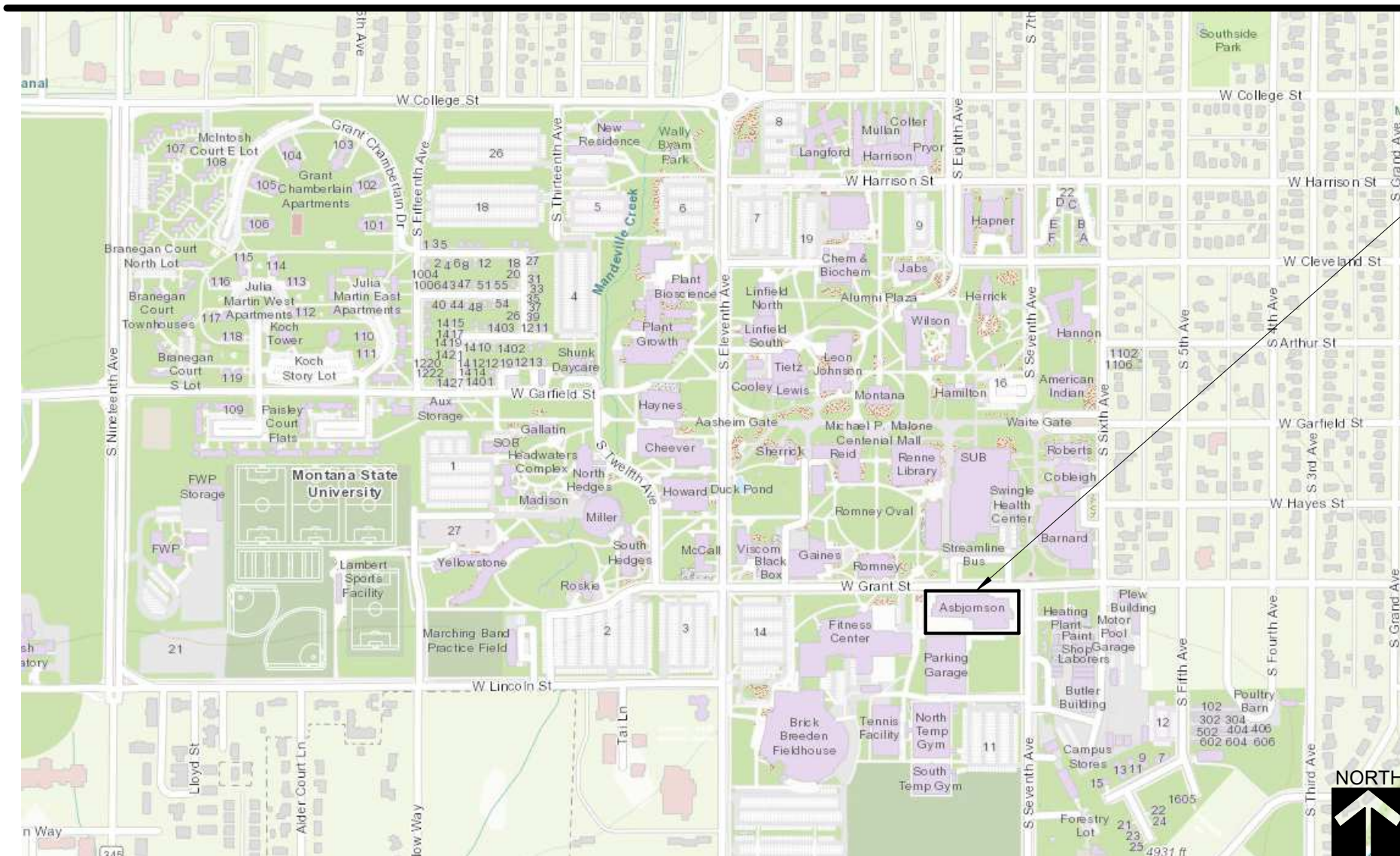

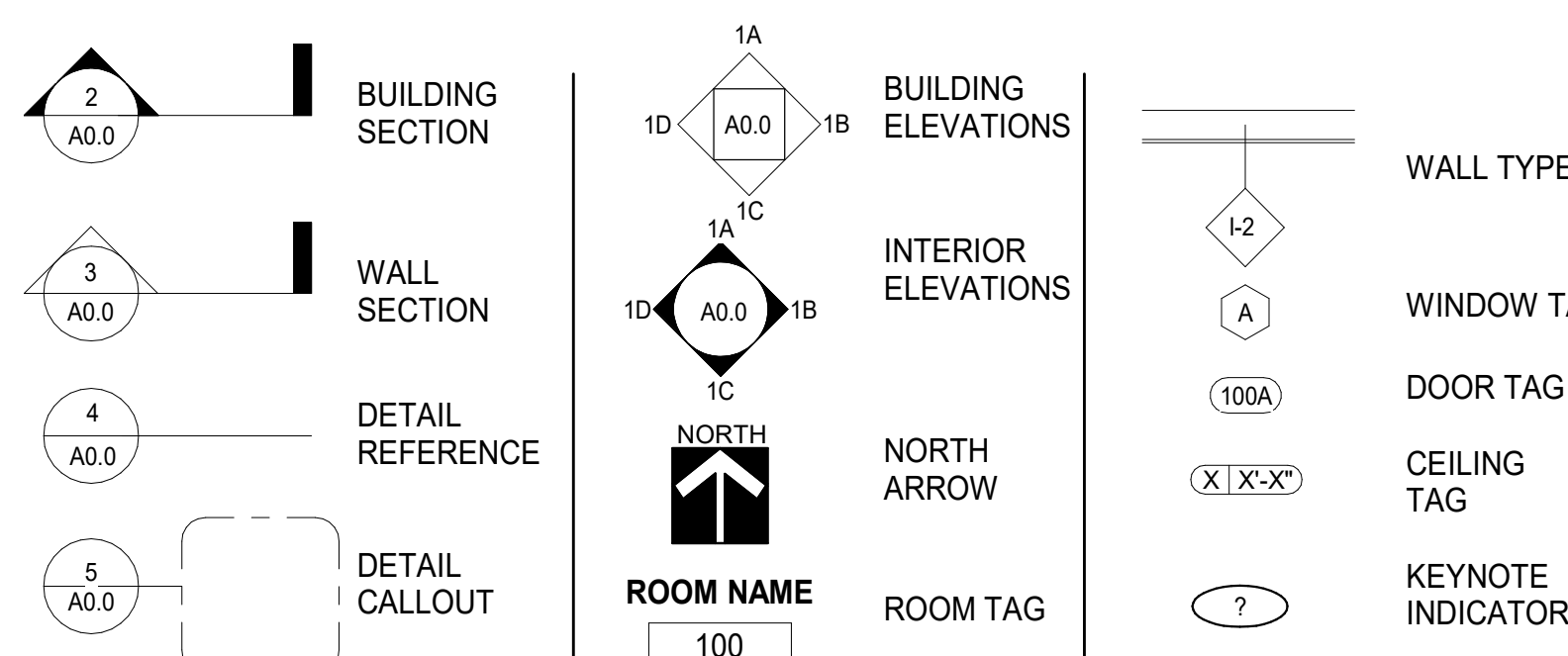

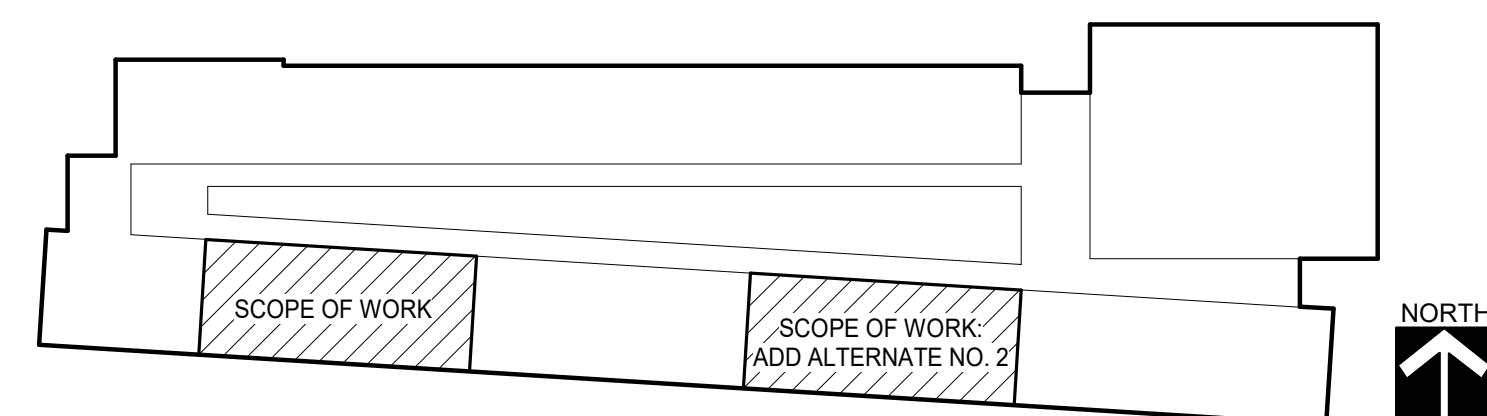

KEY PLAN - 3RD LEVEL & ROOF

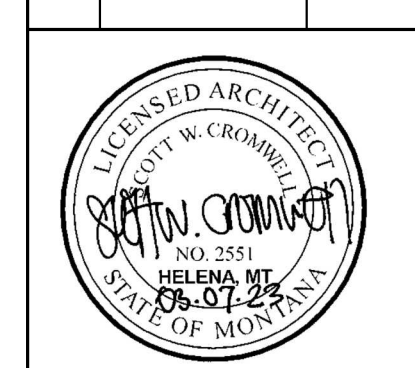

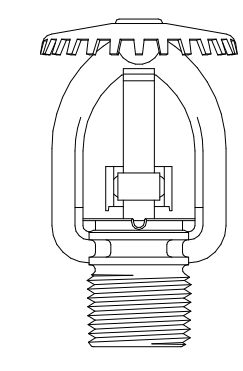

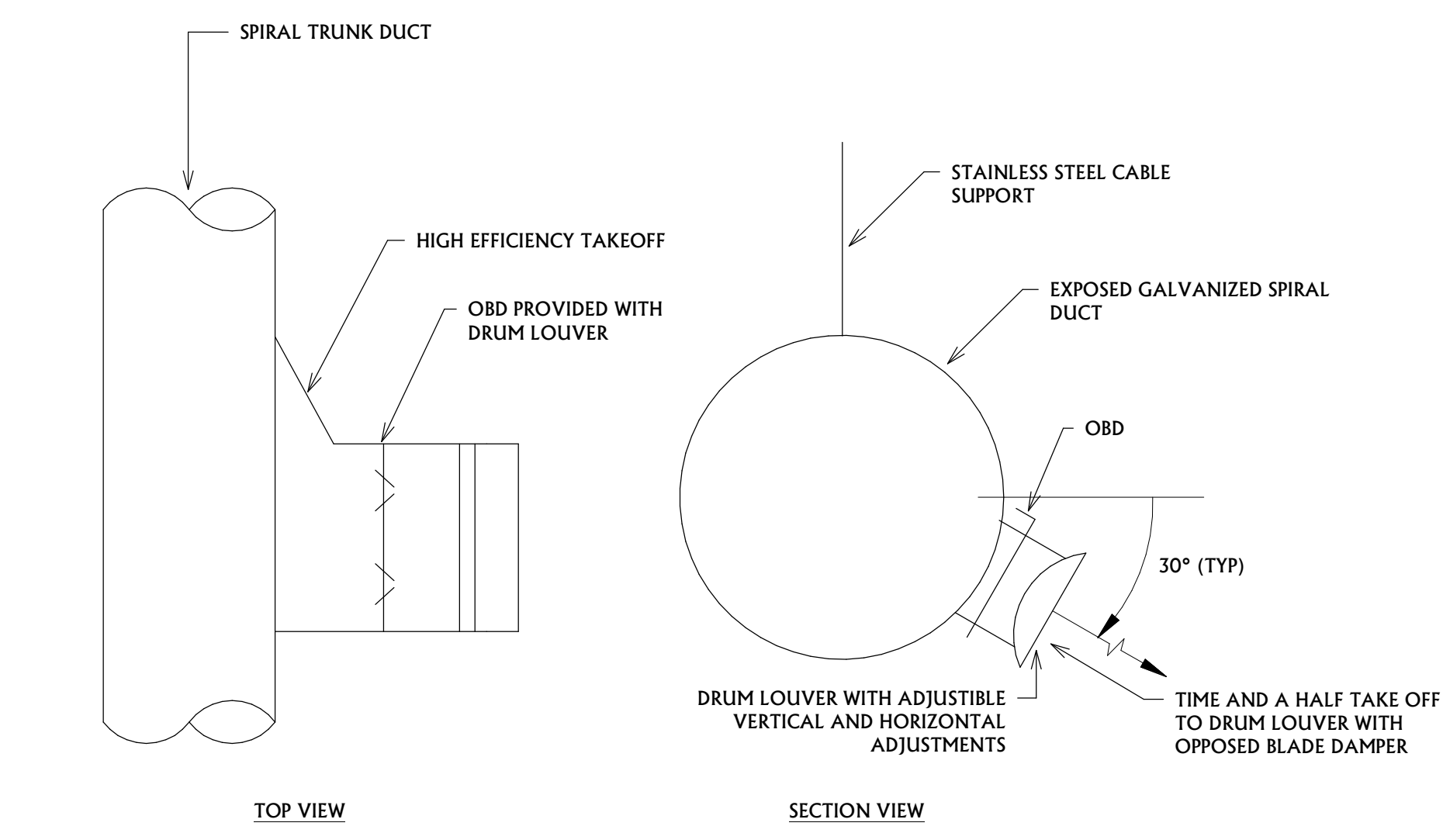

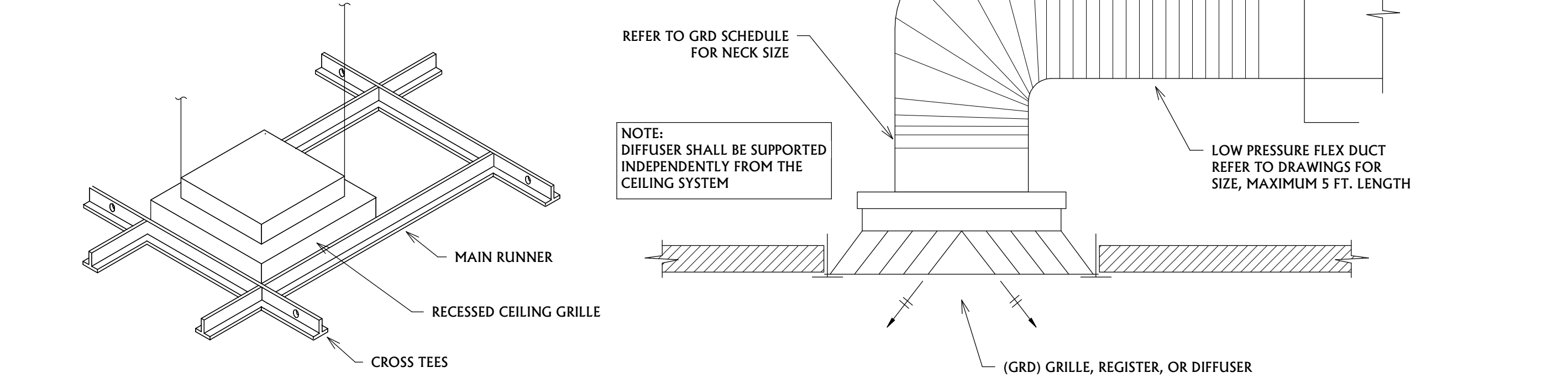


3 CONDENSATE DRAIN TRAP DETAIL

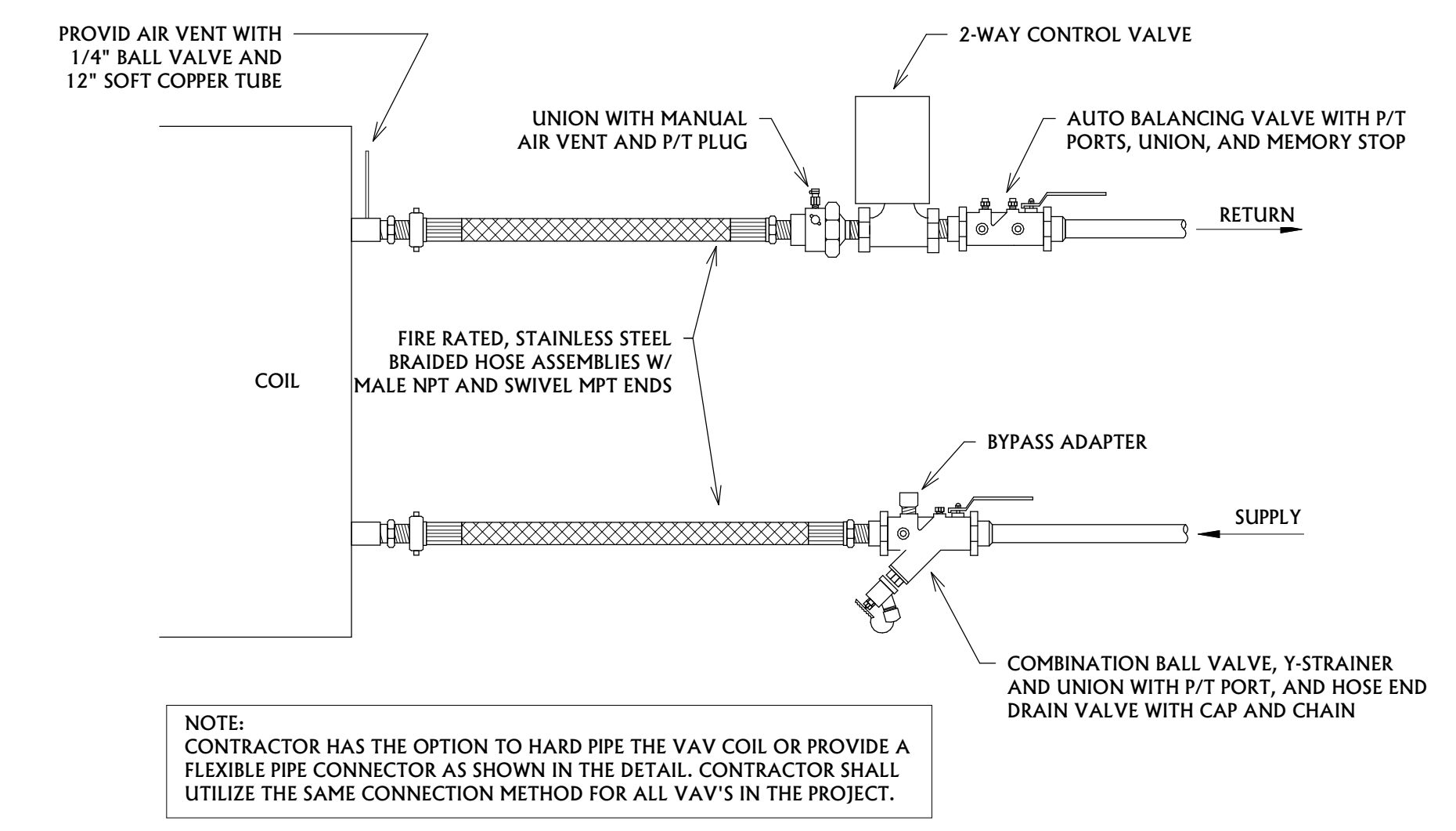


4 EXPOSED SUPPLY DUCT DRUM LOUVER DETAIL

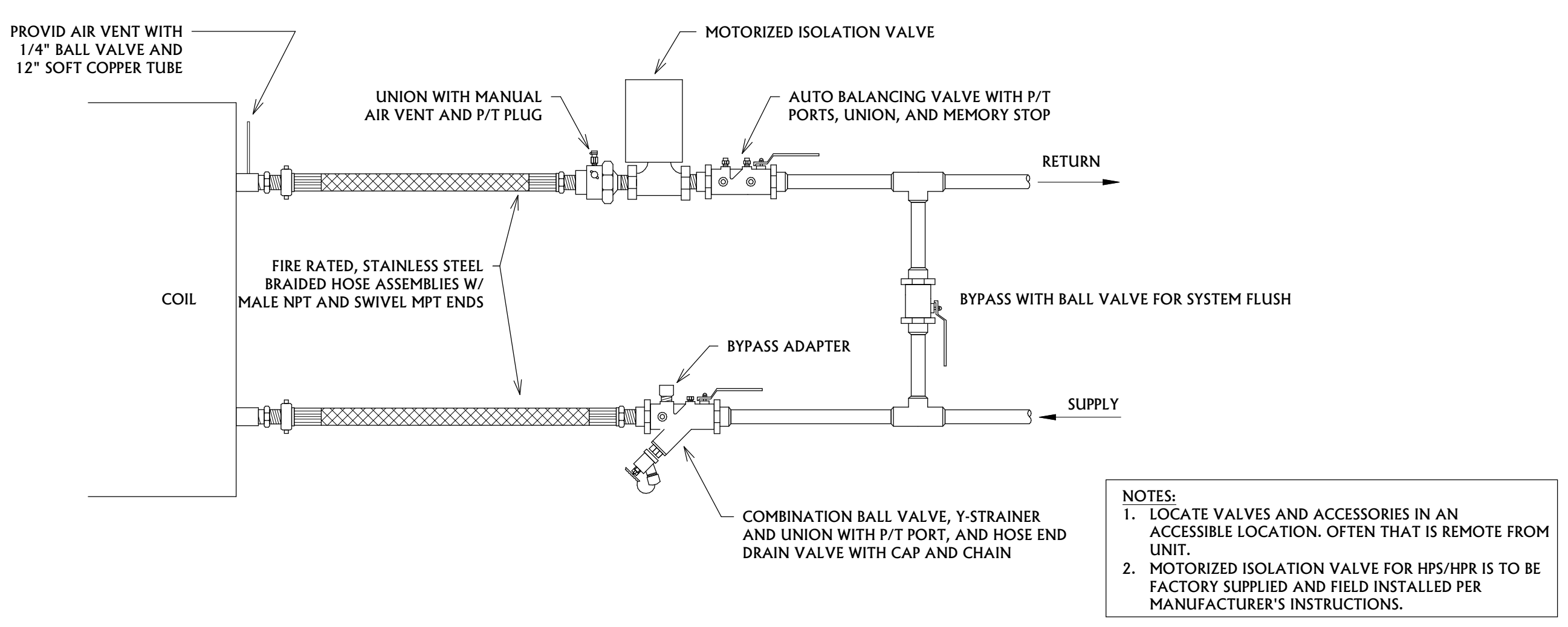

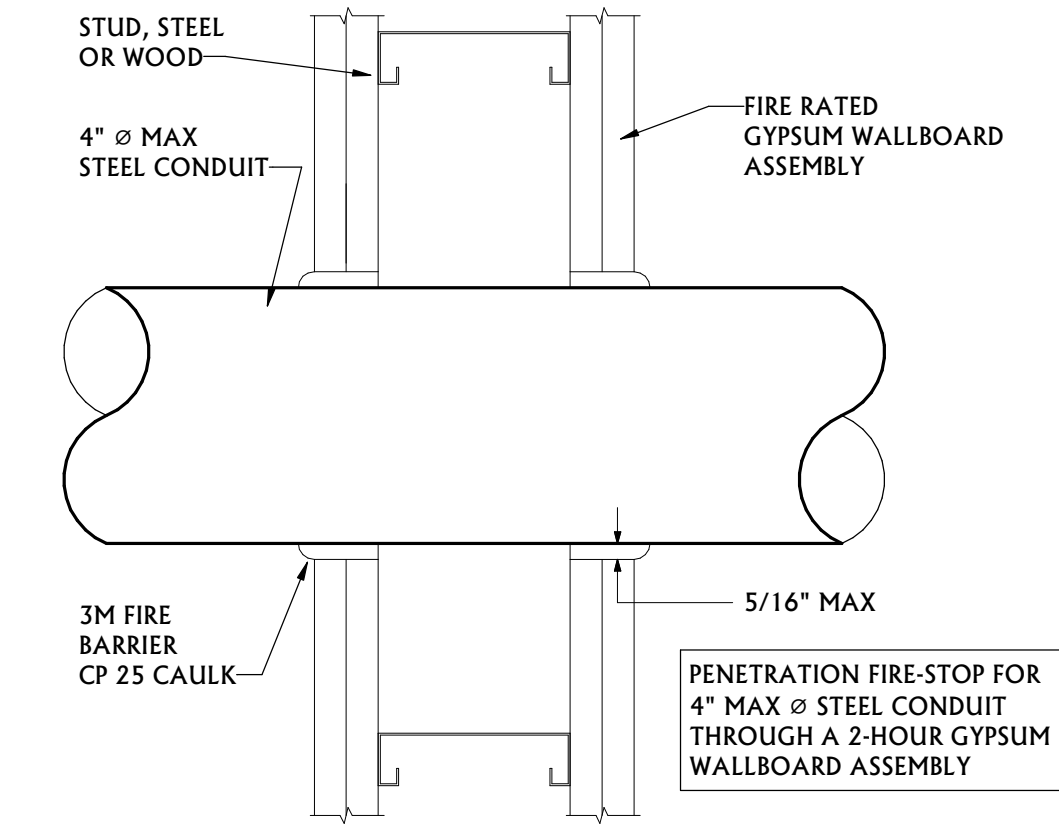
1 DOOR ROUGH-INS

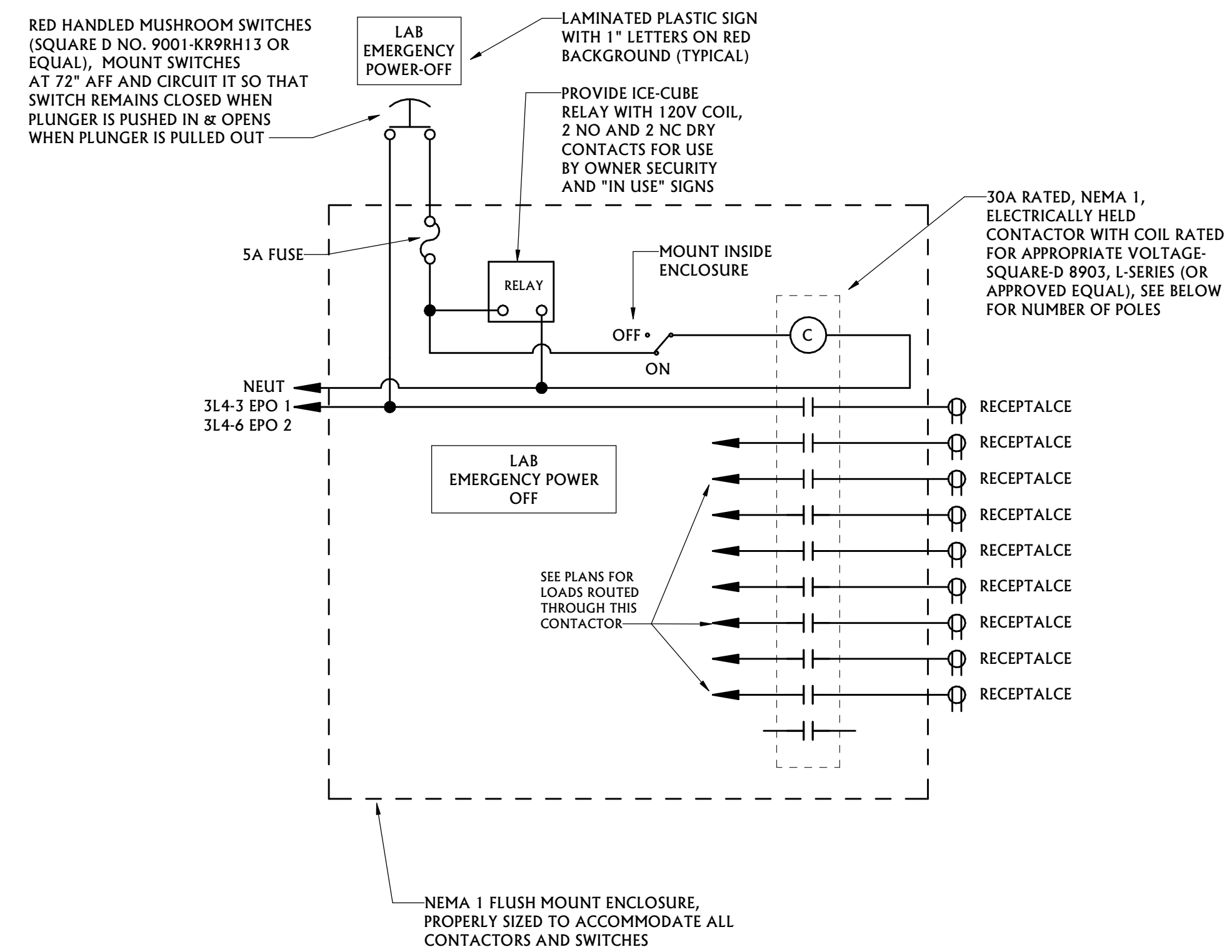
5 LAB "IN USE" SIGN WIRING

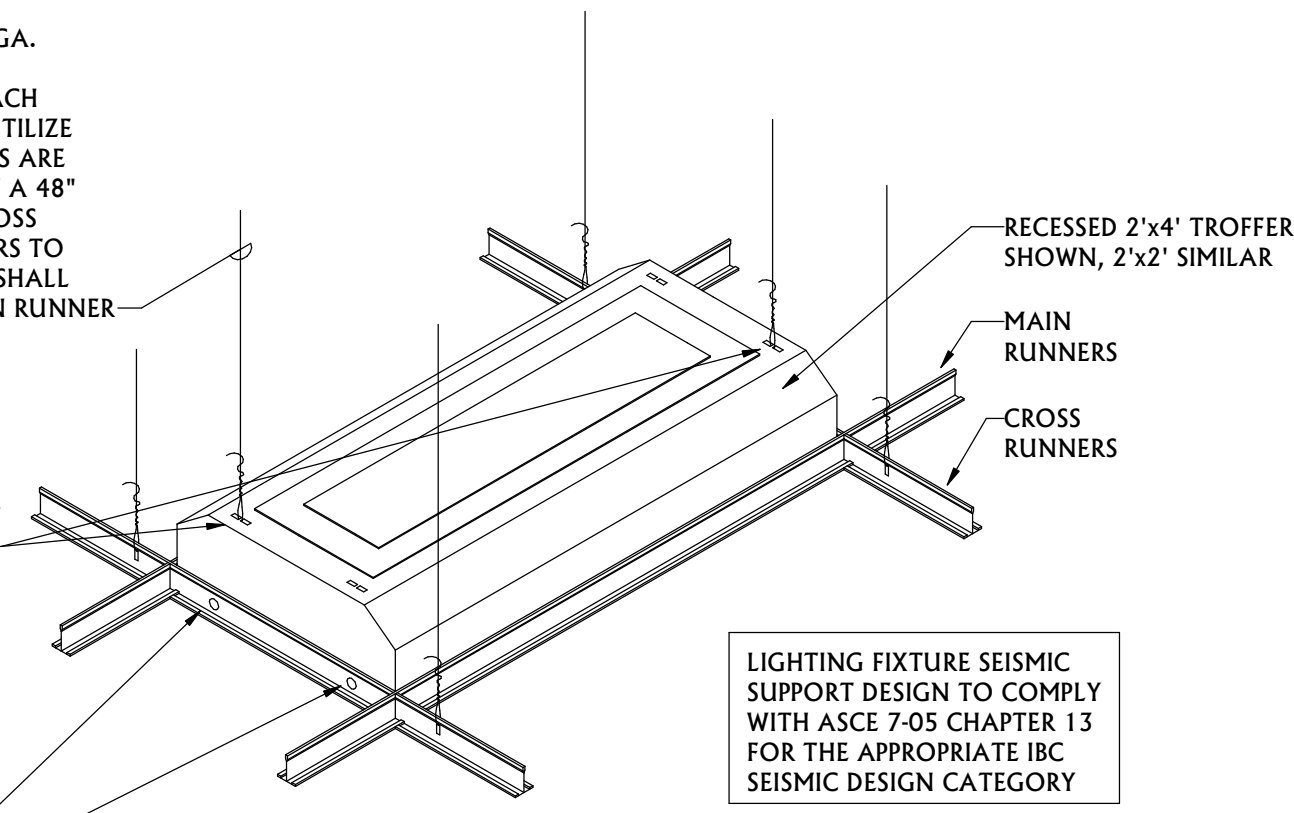

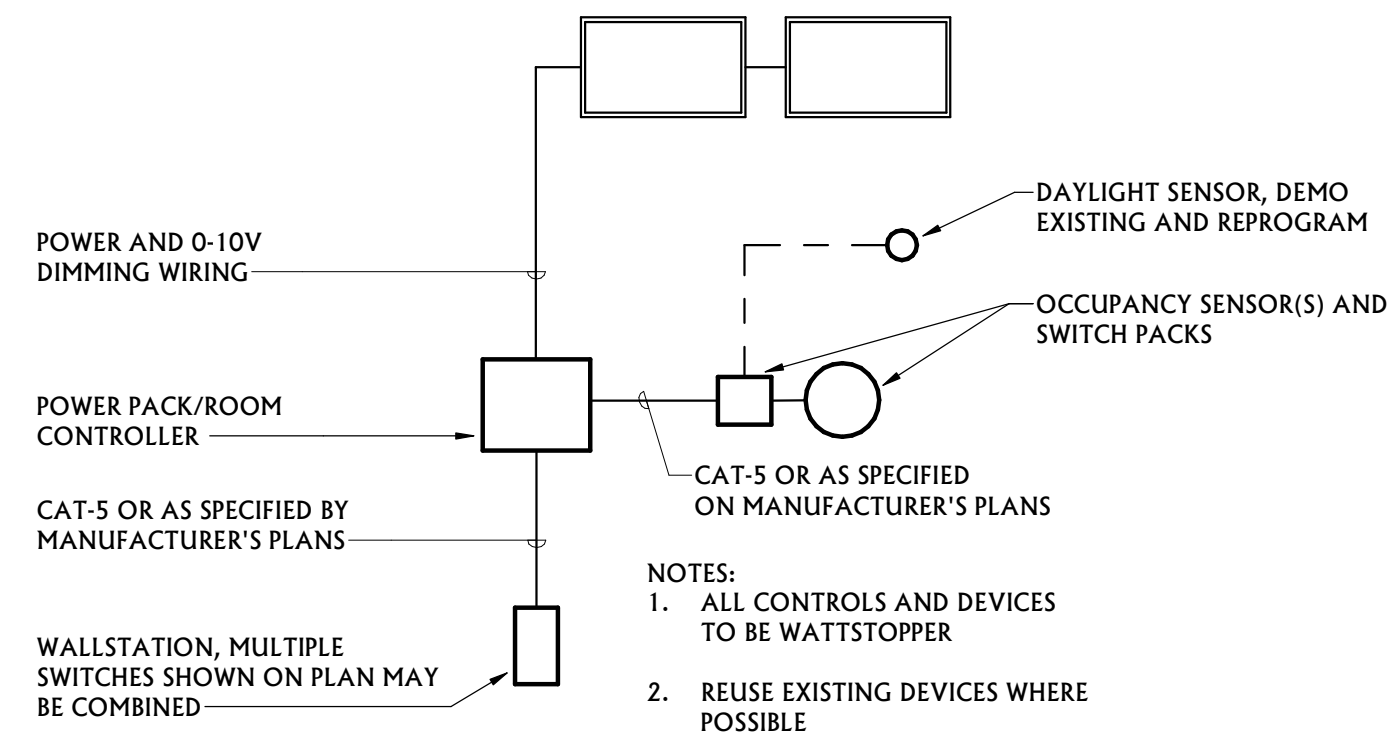

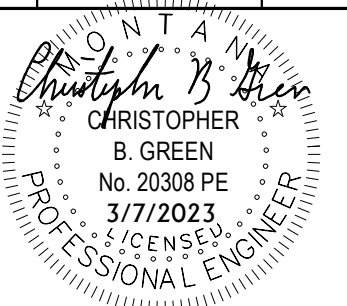
