# Webex Training overview



# What is Webex Training and who is it for?



Webex Training allows you to deliver rich, interactive online learning to up to 1,000 attendees. And whether you're giving training to employees or lectures to students, you can reach them wherever you or they happen to be. All you need is an internet connection.

What's more, you can choose both how you host and how your audience participates. Schedule a live session and, once it's underway, create smaller breakout sessions so they can put what they're learning into practice. Or offer your students access to recorded sessions, alongside specialist training software on remote computers. It's up to you.

## The biggest users of Webex Training are:

- **Human Resources departments** organizing corporate training, such as learning new software, courses on process and procedures, updates on legislation etc.
- **Teachers and specialists** from higher education or vocational schools running business courses, technology sessions, science classes, humanities seminars etc.

# Special features and key benefits

## What does Webex Training do that Webex Meetings doesn't?

Webex Training provides the same basic features as Webex Meetings, such as document and screen sharing. But it also offers a wealth of extra options you can activate before, during or after a training session, all designed to make e-learning simple, clear and convenient. Speak to your LMS provider to discuss how you can connect your LMS with Webex Training.

Check out these features and benefits.

### 01. Before the training

#### **Enhanced registration management**

Lets the host tailor the registration form to gauge the audience's level of knowledge.

#### **Automated e-commerce for paid sessions**

Allows the host to set up an online payment mechanism or generate promotion codes that can be redeemed later.

#### **Customizable invitation email**

Lets the host edit the invitation email text to include specific info about the session.

### 02. During the training

#### **Breakout sessions**

Allows sub-sessions to be created within the main session where smaller groups can hold discussions, complete exercises and create whiteboards – which can be shared with everyone in the main session at the end.

#### **Threaded Q&As**

Manages the flow of questions and answers during the session by letting students put questions directly to session panelists. A panelist can then add their answer to the thread, or assign the question to a colleague with greater expertise. They can also prioritize questions most relevant to the session, and view any unanswered questions. At the end of the session, the thread can be exported to create a FAQ document.

#### **Attendee feedback**

Gives attendees a set of emojis to show the presenter how they're finding the session.

#### **Attention indicator**

Shows the host if a student is multitasking during the session.

#### **Hands-on lab**

Grants students access to remote computers with specific software or services installed, so they can practice certain skills. Or they can reserve a time to access these computers when the session is over.

### 03. After the training

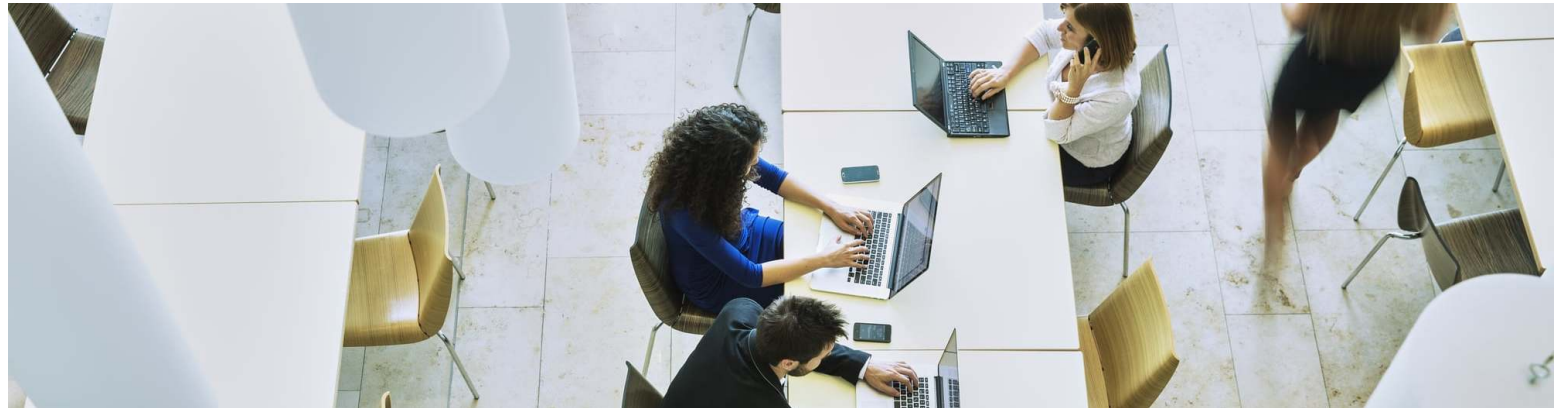
#### **Advanced reports**

Shows the host a collection of reports on usage, registrations, recording access, and promotion codes issued and used. Plus there's a record of all sessions a person has registered for or attended.

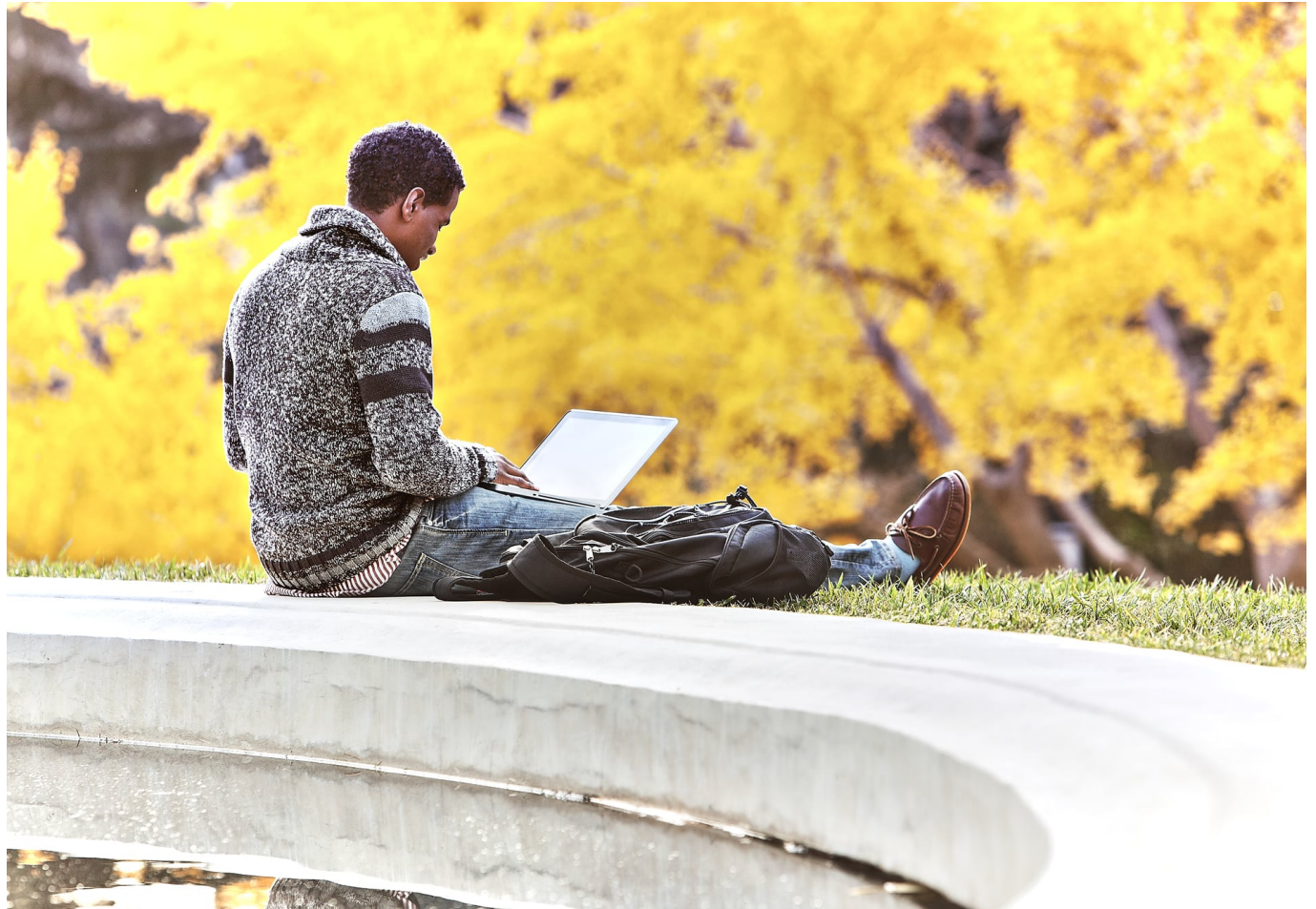

## Best practice

To give your audience the best possible Webex Training experience, be sure to follow these top tips.

### When prepping the training

- Create polls to make students feel involved and collect their feedback.
- Gauge your audience's level of knowledge by setting a pre-session test.
- Set a post-session test to check understanding.
- Want to give registrants study materials before the session? Simply add them in the scheduler.
- Charging a fee for the training? Just activate the easy-to-use e-commerce option in the scheduler.

### During training

- Use a good noise-reducing headset for best possible sound quality.
- Use an external webcam you can move around as necessary (between yourself, a whiteboard in the background, a piece of hardware etc.)
- Keep attendees engaged with regular polls.
- Keep track of questions and answers using the threaded Q&A panel. You can easily export them at the end to create a FAQ document.
- Hold discussions or complete exercises in smaller groups using breakout sessions.
- Think someone might be multitasking? Find out who with the attention indicator.
- Record the training.

### After training

- Share the training recording using the registration list, so you can follow up with anyone who views it.
- Check live class attendance, views of recordings, class attentiveness, test results etc using the reports.
- Create a space in Webex Teams, for example, where students can ask questions, learn from one another, and receive extra materials from you.

## Check knowledge and understanding in your training

Use both polling and test options in your Webex Training to interact with your attendees. Whilst polling will allow a brief moment to engage attendees and gauge their feeling or understanding, Tests will allow a more in-depth approach to check their knowledge.

## Tests and grading

Test and grade your attendees on topics or concepts that have been introduced in your training session. You can set the time limit, number of attempts, and decide how you will grade the test that is given.

Measure class performance by testing students before, during, or after live training sessions. You can even deliver tests in a number of ways including multiple choice, true or false, fill in the blank, and essay.

You can also take advantage of automated grading, reporting, and SCORM compliance, and store and reuse tests for other sessions.

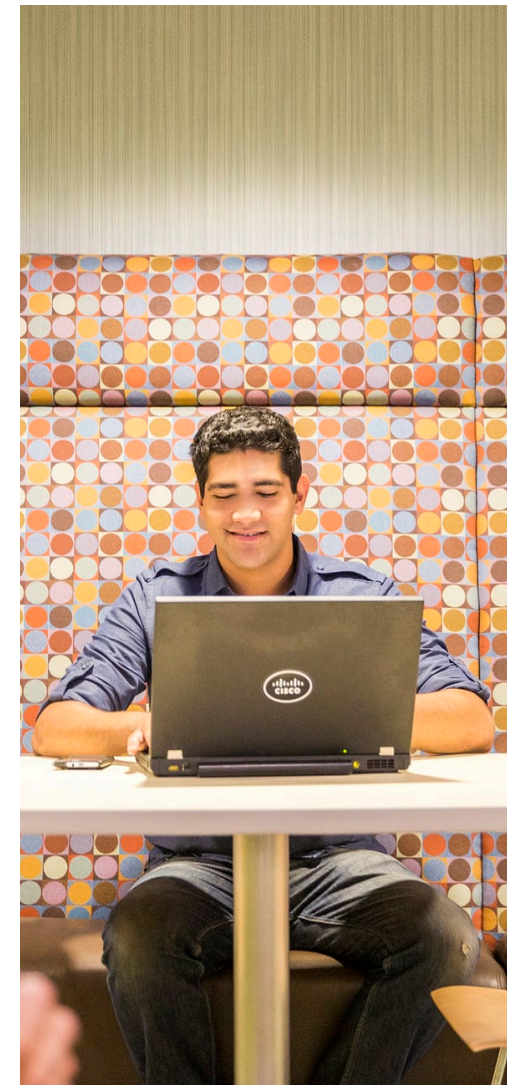

## Polling

Use poll questionnaires in your training session to get real-time feedback from your attendees, have a fun pop quiz, or vote on options in the session.

You can even download and save the results as a file for use in the future.

## Scheduling a class vs scheduling a course

Webex Training allows you to schedule both classes and courses depending on the needs of your training and attendees. You need to think about this up front before scheduling.

A **class** is an individual session on a topic, these can come in the form of:

**Single sessions** which are one-off training sessions that won't be repeated. They aren't part of a series, or "course".

**Irregular sessions** are the same training which is repeated but on a non-regular basis. This might be when there is a request for a specific training. Attendees would only attend the training once.

**Recurring sessions** happen regularly, and are scheduled in advance. This is a great option if you want to have the same training every week on a Wednesday, for example. Again, attendees would only attend the training once.

A **course** allows you to schedule multiple training sessions under one topic, and allow attendees to register only once for all sessions within the course. This is especially helpful if you are delivering a series of pieces of training towards a badge or certification.

Schedule daily, weekly, or monthly recurrences, and set end dates to the sequence of pieces of training.

## Breakout into smaller groups in Webex Training

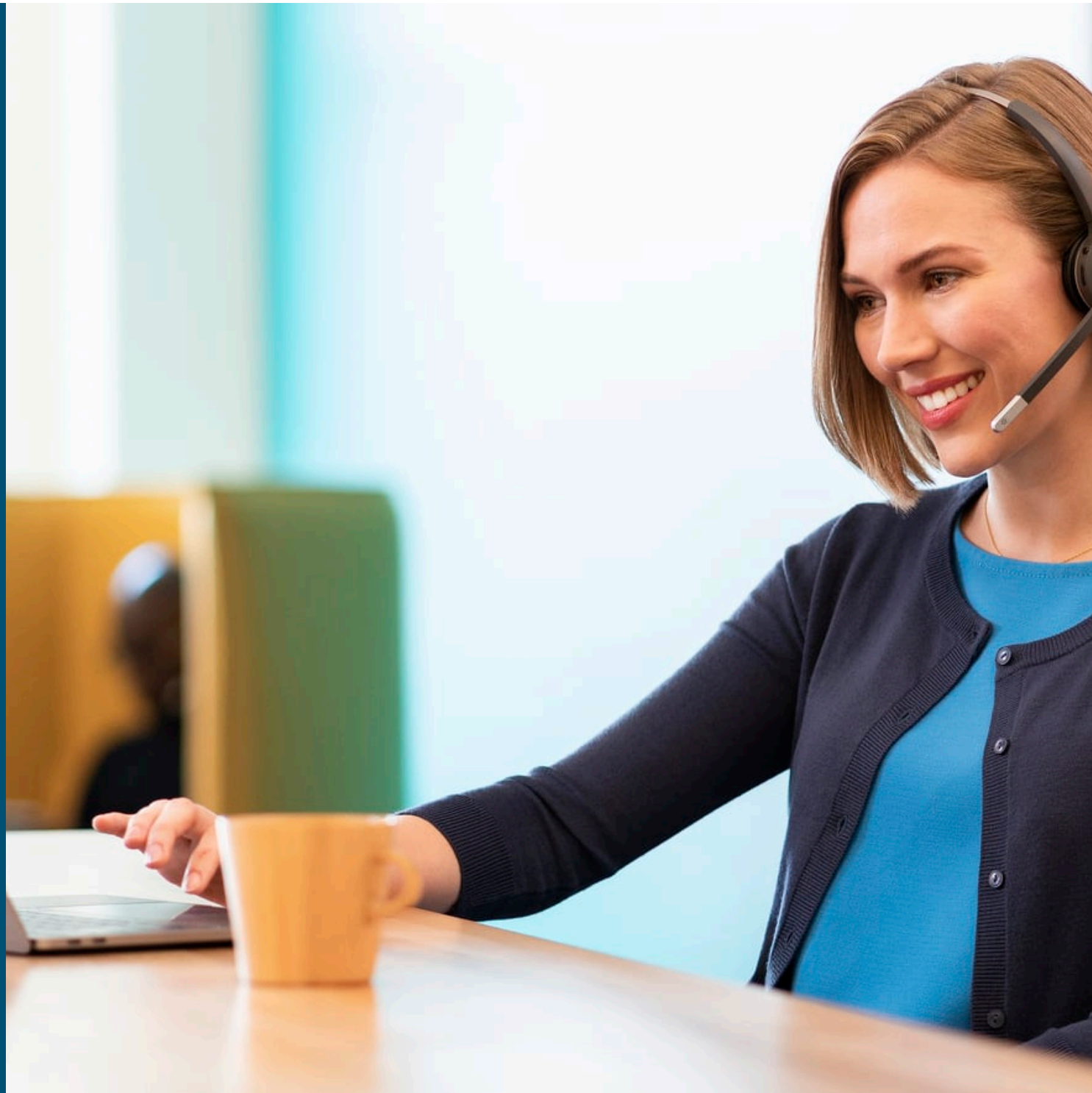
Breakout sessions can be used to place your attendees into smaller groups where they can collaborate and share ideas. Any time during a training session you can place your attendees into breakout sessions.

Breakout Sessions in Webex Training allow you to brainstorm and collaborate in real-time in small groups in a secluded area created within the main training session. These sessions allow attendees to participate actively during a lecture, in smaller more focussed groups. It's a great way to give everyone a voice.

In a Webex Training breakout session, participants can share information, chat, annotate, communicate via teleconference or VoIP, and pass the presenter ball. Recall all participants to the main training session at any time and allow them to share information from the individual breakout sessions with the whole group.

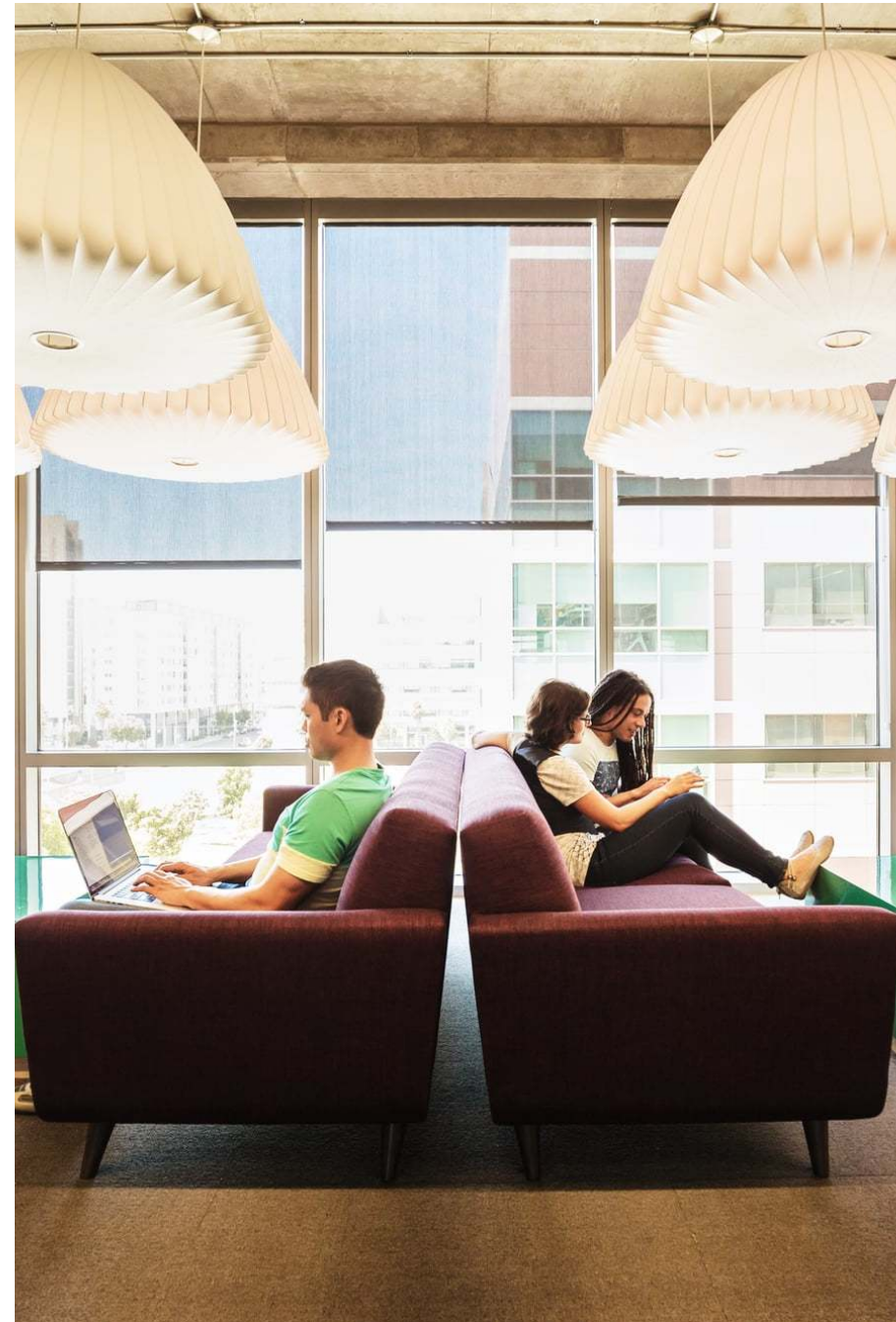

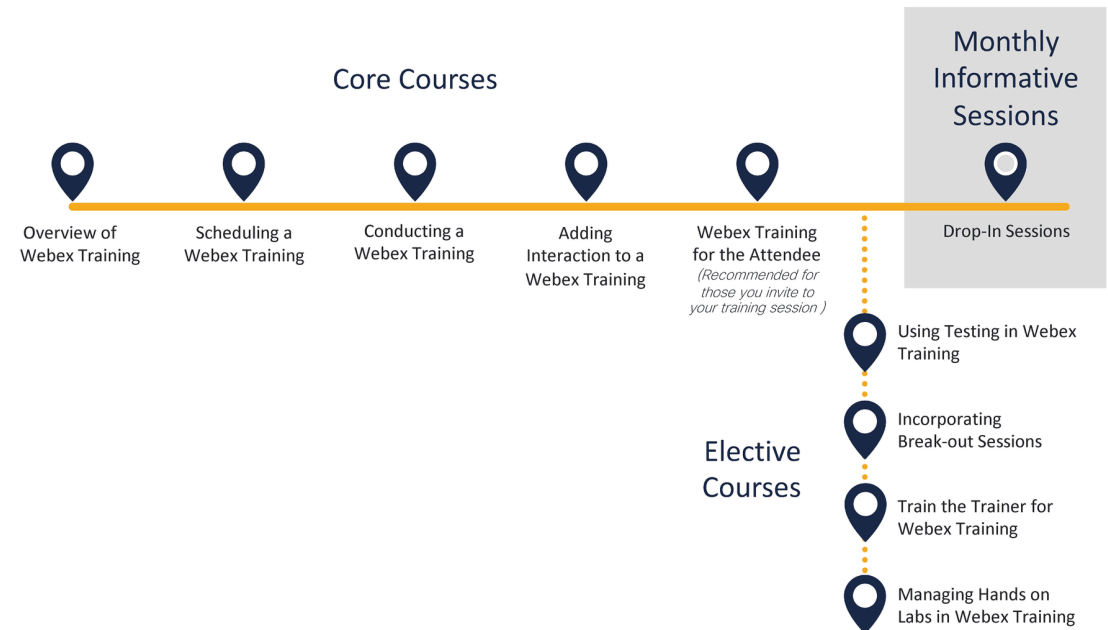
